

Dear Hebron NJHS applicant:

Students who have been at HMS for at least one full semester, and who have attained a cumulative average of 3.0 are eligible for membership in the National Junior Honor Society. Please note that this alone does NOT mean one is automatically admitted into NJHS, there is much more each individual must have completed as well. Qualifying 6th and 7th grade students are eligible for membership at HMS.

The National Junior Honor Society is the leader among organizations and societies that promote appropriate recognition for students who reflect outstanding accomplishments in the areas of scholarship, character, leadership, citizenship, and service. If chosen, as a member of NJHS students will be responsible for maintaining a cumulative average of 3.0 or higher, keeping a clean record of referrals, completing community service hours outside of school, and attending all required meetings.

Please review the membership responsibilities and bylaws carefully. For further consideration of membership, please complete the requested information and return to the NJHS box/envelope right inside Mr. Pastrick's room by January 28th at 2:40 P.M. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS DEADLINE!**

Academically qualified candidates shall be evaluated in the areas of character, leadership, citizenship, and service. **Final selection will be made by the Faculty Council, which is made up of at least 5 appointed staff members at Hebron Middle School.** Candidates will be notified no later than February 17th. If you are not selected as a member of NJHS after final selection is made, you will be reimbursed the \$10 membership fee.

The Induction ceremony will be held at 7 P.M. in the middle school gym on March ???.
